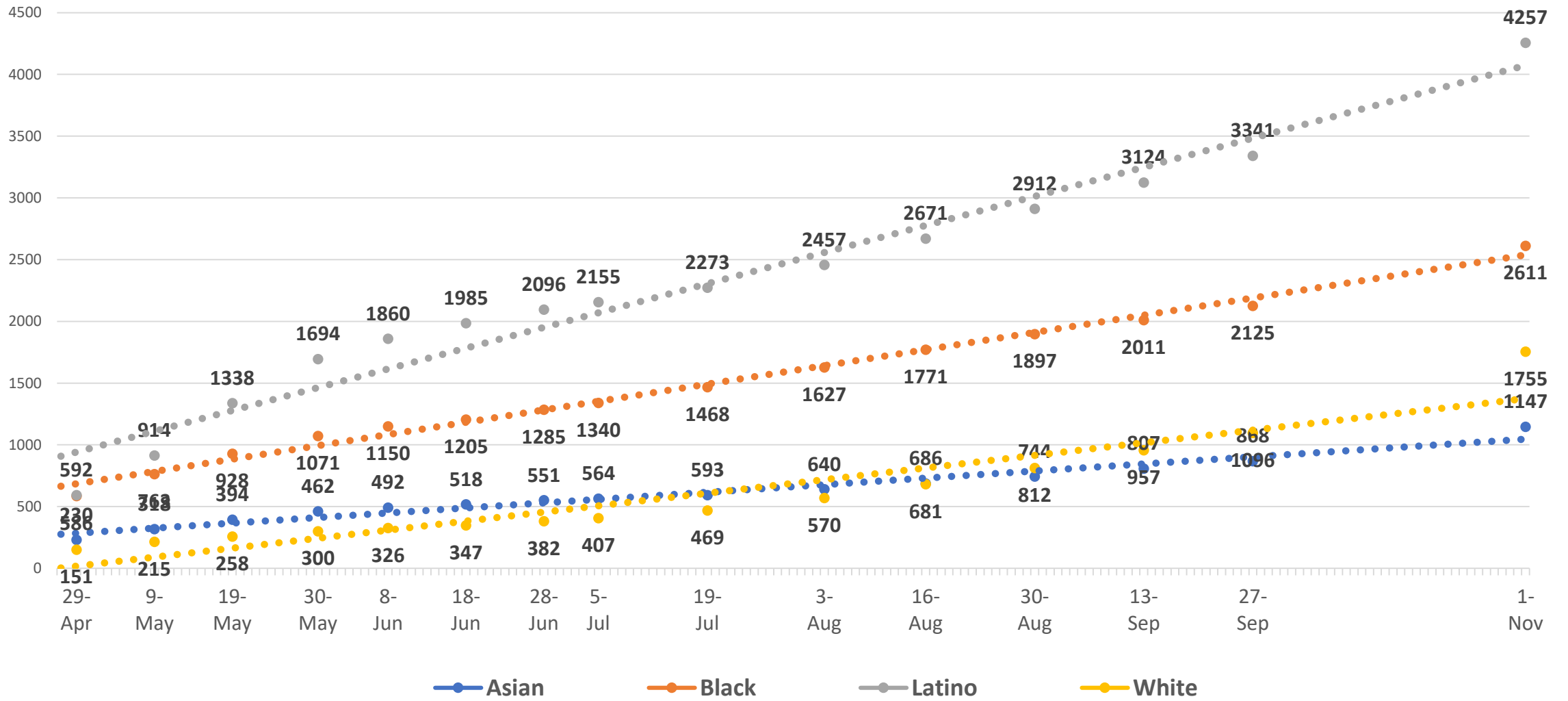
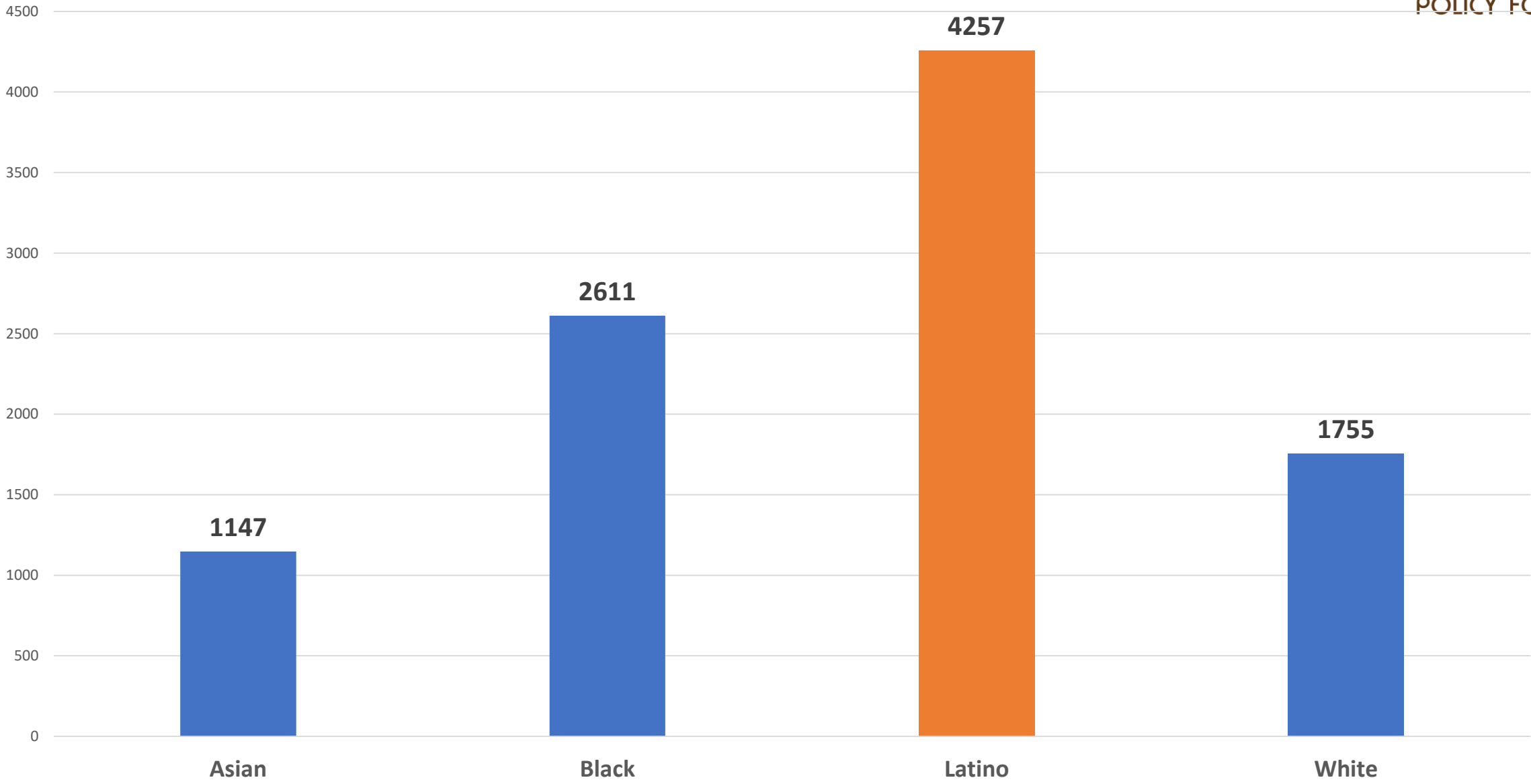


Cases of COVID-19 per 100,000 Population for Select Races/Ethnicities, Apr. 29 – Nov. 1 2020, Illinois

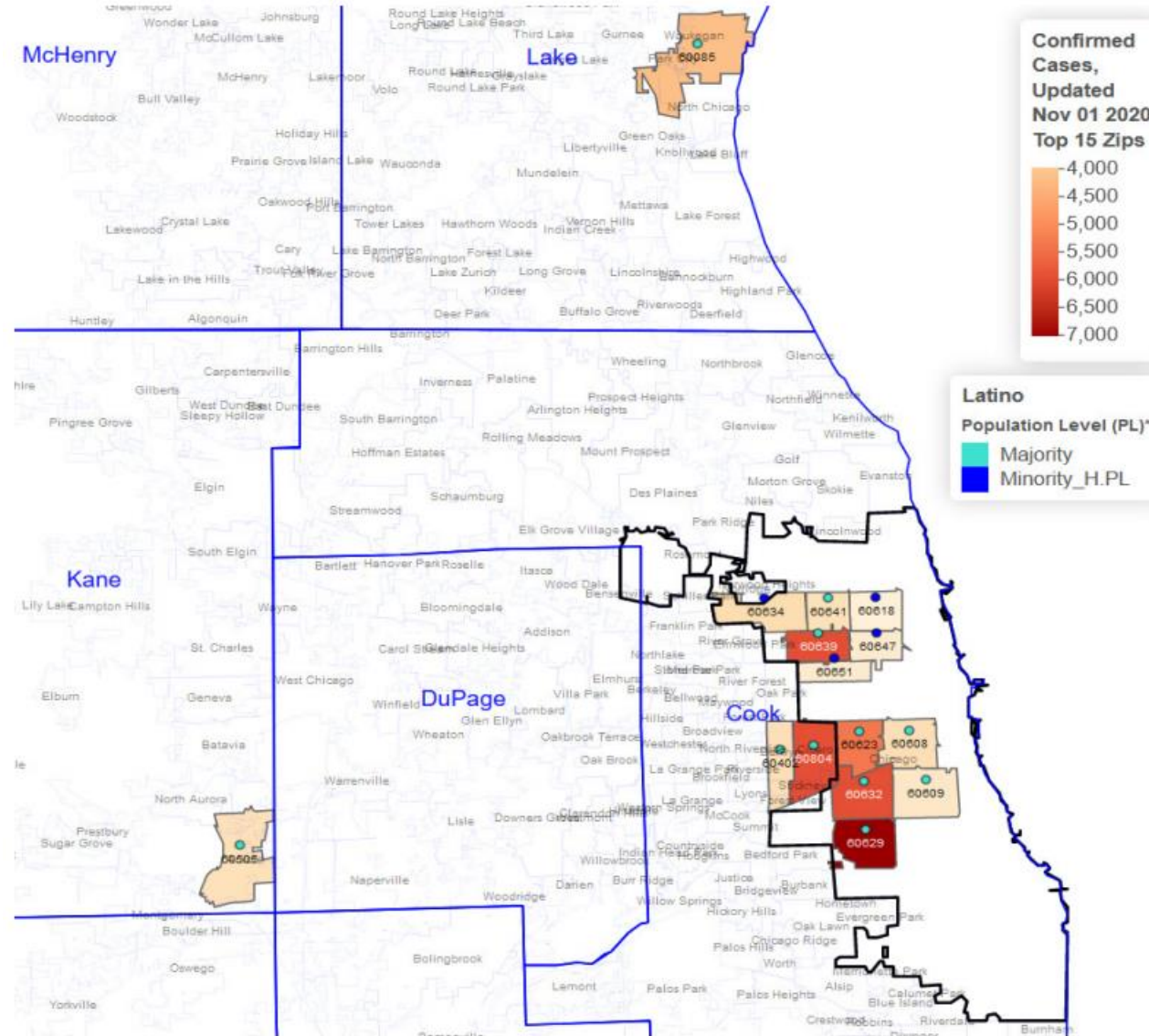
