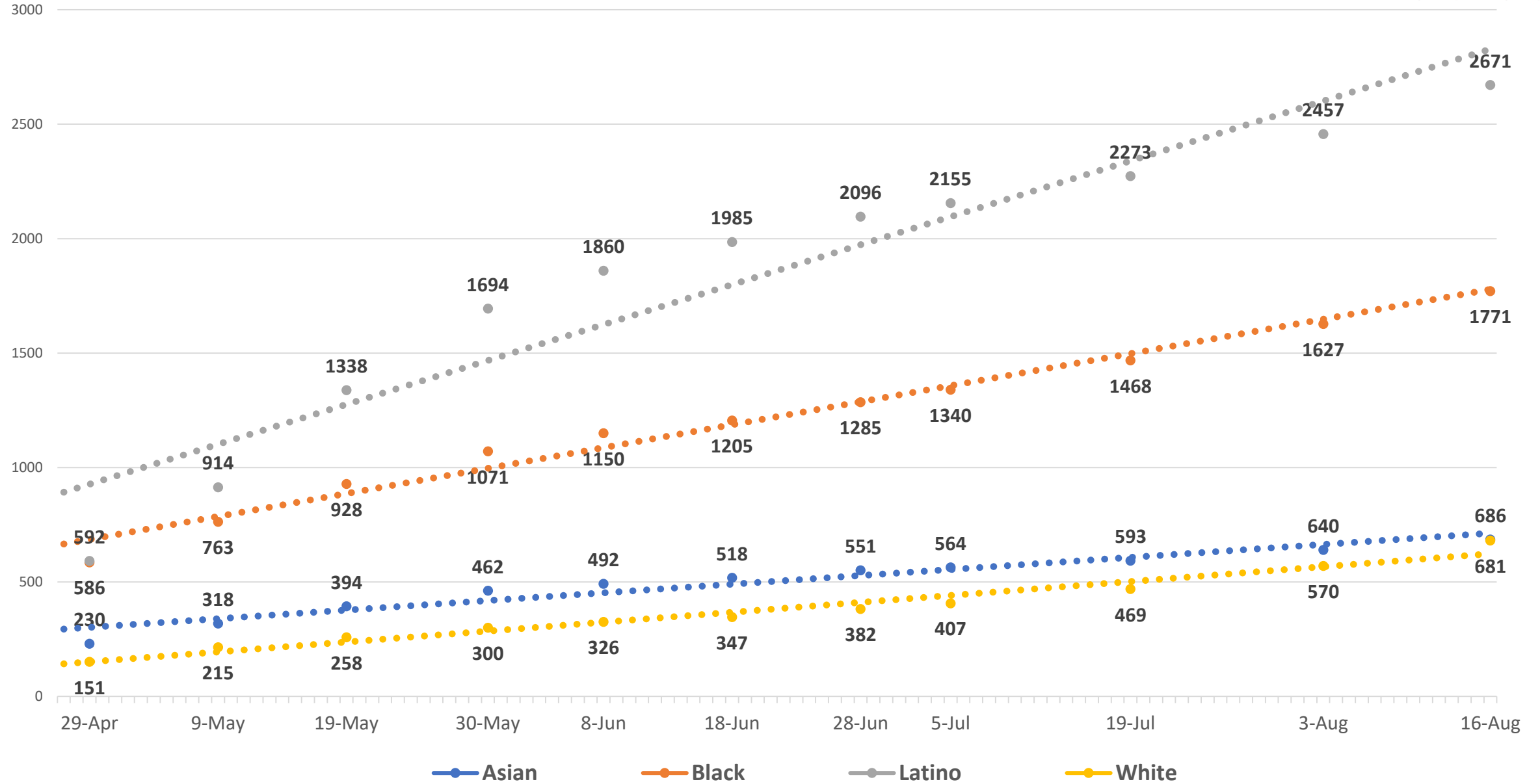
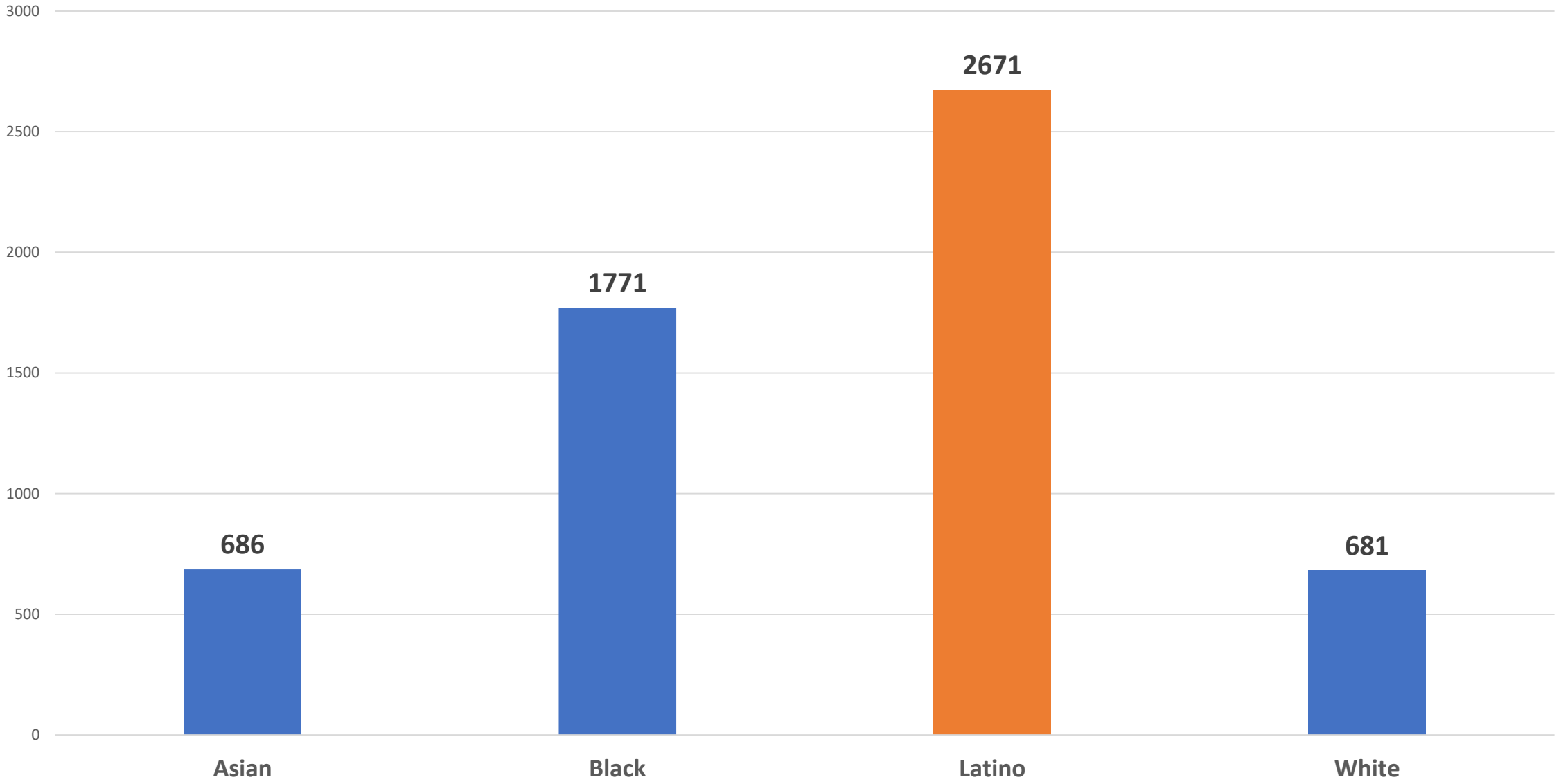


Cases of COVID-19 per 100,000 Population for Select Races/Ethnicities, Apr. 29 – Aug. 16, 2020, Illinois

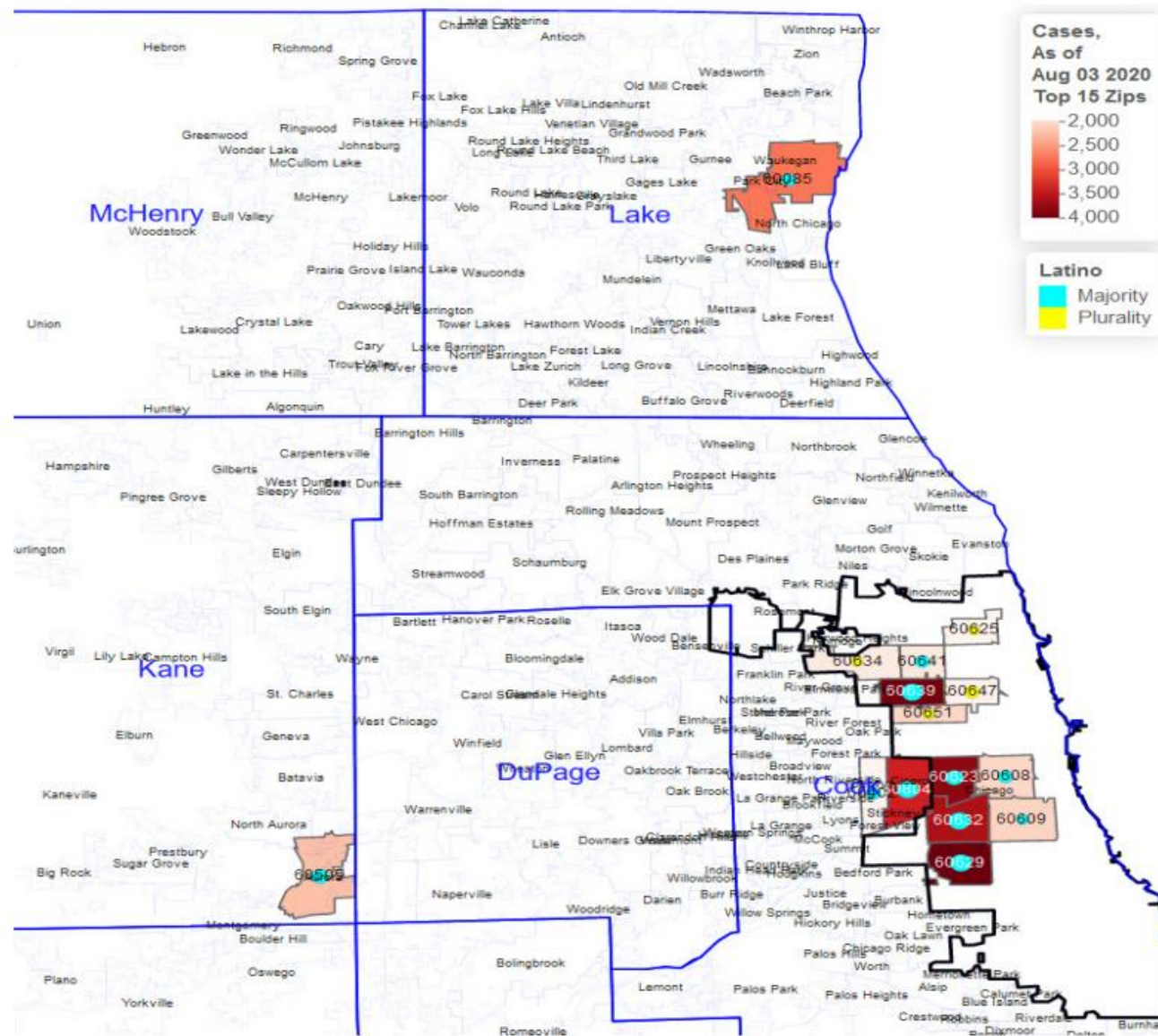
