








Children Under 18 In Families Where The Household Head Lacks A High School Diploma (2014)


Percentage of Low-Income Children Under Age 6 (2014)


Percentage of Children in Title 1 Schools (2015)


Fourth Graders Who Scored Below Proficient Reading Level (2015)




Given that Latino children have the lowest enrollment in early education, how important is it that Latino children have access to early education?






Which is the most effective strategy for engaging immigrant parents in their child's education?











How can schools best support students who are reading below grade level?



Average Composite ACT Scores (2015)






If the average ACT composite score for Latinos is 18.6 in Illinois, what kind of support is most important to boost achievement in high school?






In a global economy, how important is promoting bilingualism and literacy in more than one language?
